On Saturday, January 9, make a one-of-a-kind scarf to take home at our family friendly Nuno Felting Workshop. Larissa will teach this felting technique and offer a tiny bit of background on why it works. It is entirely done with wet felting and requires fewer supplies than needle felting. A silk chiffon scarf, roller, and color choices of roving will be provided. The cost of this workshop will be \$10 for each scarf made.

On Saturday, January 23, brighten up your winter at our DIY Felted Flowers Workshop. 
