



Anyone who has visited the Regional Artists Gallery or the special shows at the Center for the Arts has undoubtedly seen Toni's exquisite baskets. (If you haven't, stop by the Center; several pieces are currently on display.) Each basket is unique. Many of them are tiny, and these fit perfectly into the current show, "Small is Beautiful."

This is not unusual: Toni often creates works that fit in with a particular theme, such as her black and white baskets in the "Shades of Gray" show. As an artist, that challenge is one of the things she especially enjoys about exhibiting at the Center. "Figuring out how my work would fit in to the theme of a show has helped me be more creative," she comments.

Toni sees the Center for the Arts as a wonderful place for artists to exhibit and/or perform, as well as for the public to experience their work. As a Board member, she welcomes the way the Center has expanded to present a whole variety of art forms. She especially looks forward to the day when the Center has a theater.

Along with her work at the Center for the Arts, Toni is active in various other cultural activities, managing "Hello Galena" and serving as treasurer of the Galena Cultural Arts Alliance. She exhibits her baskets at several other venues, including the Roundtree Gallery in Platteville. Her work was featured in the Artists' Guild's last show at Chestnut Mountain and is sold in various art fairs. This winter she will be teaching a class in Palm Springs, where she and her husband recently bought a winter home.

Not surprisingly, all this keeps Toni extremely busy. How fortunate we are that she is channeling so much of her time, energy, and talent into the Center for the Arts!
