The Regional Artists Gallery at the Galena Center for the Arts presents a fascinating kaleidoscope of

artwork by over 30 artists from Galena IL, Dubuque IA, Mineral Point WI and surrounding communities. New exhibits are installed bi-monthly, coinciding with special exhibits. During March and April, we will also showcase artwork by local Arts Educators in our Hallway Gallery. We are proud to honor these teachers who nourish and inspire creativity in their students. Major research groups have documented the positive impact the arts have on developmental growth in children, enhancing critical thinking skills, self-esteem, and higher success in academic classes like math and science.

NEW EXHIBIT OPENS MARCH 4TH

Jac Tilton is a former art educator and has held various management positions in advertising, marketing, graphic design and web development.

He has worked almost exclusively in watercolor for most of his career, but recently has added nonrepresentational works in graphite, carbon and charcoal to his portfolio.

Tilton's drawings have been included in the Strokes of Genius: Best of Drawing series, volumes 2, 4, 5, 6 and 8 and his watercolor, "Waiting for the CTA", received Best of Show honors at the Illinois Watercolor Society's 29th National Juried Exhibition.

He is a signature member of the Illinois Watercolor Society and signature member of the Iowa Watercolor Society.

Jac is also a member of the National Watercolor Society and the Transparent Watercolor Society.



Beginning with childhood paper dolls, chains, pop-out books, and greeting cards, Gail Chavenelle has been intrigued by paper sculpture. She loved the forms, but wanted the works to be more permanent. Instead of sheets of paper, she works with sheets of steel.

Gail is interested, as in paper sculpture, in creating expanded and three dimensional images from a flat sheet. Many designs are one-piece.

Chavenelle is known for her stylized figure sculptures in steel. The curvilinear figurative forms exhibit an organic quality that transcends the connotations of the medium. Instead of harsh edges, there is line and movement. Her sculptures have been called "Sketches in Metal."



Serving on the Board, where she contributes to the decision-making about the Center's present and future, Diann is enthusiastic about the community's reception. "It's been amazing!" she exclaims. "The community of Galena has supported each and every art display with enthusiasm. It's also amazing to discover the wide variety of artistic talents possessed by area residents."

Since her primary interests are in the visual and written arts, it's not surprising that one of Diann's most visible achievements has been the establishment of the Arts Resources Library at the Center. She has made it a comfortable spot where a visitor can enjoy browsing through books on the arts. "It makes me happy to walk by and see someone sitting there reading," she comments.

Diann's energy and talents have been apparent ever since she and her husband Robert moved to Galena almost seventeen years ago. While involved in many activities like the Friends of the Library, the Writers' Guild, and now the Center for the Arts, she has somehow found time to both write and paint. Some of her artwork has been displayed at the Center, and her work will also be



exhibited in a show planned for the Parish House of the Episcopal Church.

Diann's writing has appeared in the Writers' Guild two books. Even more impressive, she has written two books about Galena's history and its houses and neighborhoods, and she is working on a third. Her subject matter reflects her love of old houses. She and Robert moved here because "We wanted to live in a Victorian house on a historic street in a community that protects its historic buildings." How lucky for them—and for us—that they found what they wanted in Galena.
