Supply List

- Option One - Waterproof (felt tip) ink pens in several size tips, a good one is Faber-Castell 4PITT Artist Pens, Black with S, M, F and B, small, medium, fine and brush.
- Option Two - any portable sketch pen with waterproof ink, there are some very nice fountain pens that I use for sketching – example: Lamy pen, Noodler, Platinum Carbon Ink Pen, and one of my favorites the Very Fine Waterproof Sharpie pen.
- Sketch pad, a size you are comfortable using—not too small please—with paper heavy enough to accept watercolor. I use an inexpensive 80 lb. sketch or mixed media pad from Blick Art.
- Soft pencils, sharpener, and kneaded eraser.
- Portable water container.
- Small set of watercolors or watercolor pencils.
Watercolor brushes in several sizes.
I use a # 6 and #10 round with fine tips.
One or two brushes are sufficient.
- Rags or paper towel for cleanup.
- Portable chair for onsite sketching.
- Photos of Galena to use in case of inclement weather.
- Students are encouraged to bring any photos they would like help in developing and to work on in case of inclement weather.
